## 2022 COLLEGE FEES AND LEVIES SCHEDULE – GENERAL INFORMATION

### INTRODUCTION

As a non-government not-for-profit school, the College does not receive sufficient funds from the State and Federal governments to cover all operating costs. As such, we are heavily reliant on the timely payment of fees and levies by families to ensure we maintain our financial sustainability and level of service, now and into the future.

Our Finance team raises fees and levies four times a year to correspond with each of the four terms. Statements must be settled within 14 Days, unless a **current payment plan** has been approved. All fees and levies must be finalised by the end of the school year.

### TUITION FEES

Set by Brisbane Catholic Education and the College Board, Tuition fees are charged on a **sliding family scale** and contribute toward general tuition resources as well as the administrative and operating costs of the College.

### CAPITAL LEVY

The Capital Levy is a compulsory **family rate** levy providing essential support for the capital development and maintenance of our College. Each year the College commits to further building and maintenance works coupled with updates to teaching and learning equipment. This levy is **not tax deductible**.

### PARENTS & FRIENDS (P&F) LEVY

The P&F Levy is charged on a **family rate**. This levy provides funds so that the P&F can contribute to special projects around the College for the benefit of students.

### CURRICULUM AND RESOURCE LEVY

This levy is charged **per student**. This levy includes, **but is not limited to**, items such as:

- Teaching Requisites.
- Subject Materials/Resources and Photocopying.
- Transport to Sports/Major Events.
- Guest Speakers/Presenters.
- ICT Platform and Laptop Program.
- Tertiary Access Program (Year 12).
- Locker Maintenance and One Lock.
- Pastoral Care Activities.
- Academic Competitions.
- Student ID Card (one per year).
- Personal and Social Development.
- Student Insurance (CCI).
- Academic Ceremonies.
- Religious Education Activities.
- Camps and Retreats (some off-site).
- Affiliations.
- Some subject excursions, entry and transport costs.

**Please note: No refunds will be issued for non-attendance of any activity included in this levy.**

### BOOK HIRE LEVY

All families are required to pay an annual Book Hire Levy of \$50.00 for **each student**. Please note that this levy will be charged in full in Term 1 and will be used to offset the costs of maintaining the Textbook Hire Scheme and ensuring that students have the most up-to-date texts available.

Damaged or lost textbooks will incur replacement costs in addition to the fee and will be charged to your family account accordingly.





## COLLEGE YEARBOOK

The College Yearbook is distributed as **one** copy per family.

## METHODS OF PAYMENT

Many payment options are available for families to meet their financial commitment to the College, including Direct Debit, BPay, Qkr!, EFTPOS (Debit and Credit Card), BPOINT, Cheque or Cash. Located in the foyer of the Champagnat building, the Finance Office is open to accept payments **Monday to Friday from 8.00 am - 3.30 pm** during the school term.

Payment plans to suit your family budget can be organised with payments accepted over weekly, fortnightly or monthly timeframes. **Families setting up payment plans will need to contact the College Finance Office to ensure that correct payment plan calculations are provided so that the family account is finalised by the end of the year.**

**A discount of 5% will be offered to families wishing to pay their full year of fees and levies by the Term 1 due date.**

## FEE CONCESSIONS

Concessions are available for families who are experiencing financial difficulties, and application forms are available from the College Finance Office on 07 3810 5900 or via email - [SRIVFinance@bne.catholic.edu.au](mailto:SRIVFinance@bne.catholic.edu.au).

Please note the following conditions:

- Concessions are available on Tuition Fees only.
- Concessions are not ongoing from year to year, and new applications need to be resubmitted at the commencement of each school year.
- Families eligible for concession are required to pay their account via direct debit plan or Centrepay.
- All fees and levies need to be finalised by the end of the school year.
- The 5% discount offered for paying a full year of fees upfront, **DOES NOT** apply to family accounts with a concession applied.

## EXITING STUDENTS

Fees will be payable for the whole term in which the enrolment is terminated. For a reduction in fees, a written request must be made to the Principal/Business Manager at the time of notification and may be granted at the discretion of the Principal/Business Manager.

## ACTIVITIES NOT INCLUDED IN THE FEES AND LEVIES SCHEDULE

The following additional fees are not included in the 2022 Student Fees and Levies Schedule, and will not be added to the Statement of Fees and Levies unless prior approval has been given by the Business Manager:

- Certificate Subjects as well as Construction/Engineering Uniforms and Chef's Jackets and Hats.
- End of Year Activities, Graduations, Formals and Senior Jerseys.
- Confraternity Rugby League/QISSN.
- Dance Costumes, Eisteddfods and Junior Elite Dance.
- Specific Camps for Biology and Visual Arts.
- Private Instrumental/Music Lessons.
- Additional ID Passes and Locks.

**Applicable course costs will be added in full to family fee statements at the commencement of the course.**

Students may be eligible for fee subsidy for course costs by accessing allocated VETiS Funding. For students that have already accessed their VETiS Funding, you will be required to pay the full cost including RTO charges and course consumables

For Certificate I in Construction and Certificate II in Engineering the course fee of \$1200.00 is only charged once if courses are completed simultaneously.

Please note that RTO costs will not be refunded for changes of mind after the statutory 'cooling off' period. Monies paid on your behalf by the College cannot be recovered from the RTO irrespective of whether the course is completed or not. Refunds of course consumable costs may be available on a pro-rata basis, depending on the timing of purchases and subject to approval from the Business Manager.
